2006 Duet Cabernet Sauvignon - Merlot

Appearance
Vibrant plum colour.

Bouquet
Leafy mulberry fruits with cigarbox oak complexity and a hint of chocolate and earthiness.

Palate
A soft juicy berry flavoured entry with ripe dark plum, roasted chestnut and balanced ripe tannins.
A rich, ripe, soft and complex wine that is great with meals.

Winemaking

The majority of the Cabernet Sauvignon (64%) and Merlot (36%), were sourced from our Malpas Ridge vineyard. Harvest was in March 2006. The Cabernet components were matured in two and three year old American and French oak. The Merlot was barrel fermented in two year old French oak. The wine was matured over a 20 month period.

Ageing

This wine is made to be enjoyed now while it is fresh, young and fruity.
