He's now a popular member of the Fox Creek team and loves running up and down the rows of vines. "His" 2007 unwooded chardonnay is a pleasant fruit-driven drop that would go well with spinach and fetta quiche, chicken vol-au-vent or fish with lime and black pepper sauce. It is pale yellow and has a tropical fruit salad nose. Juicy golden peach flavour shows on the front of the palate and creamy, melon characters chime in on the middle palate. The finish has soft

flinty acid."
